“CDCs: The ‘Hole’ Story”

Dr Craig Morton

St Vincent’s Institute of Medical Research

Dr Morton completed his PhD at the Ludwig Institute for Cancer Research before spending several years as a Post-doc with Prof Iain Campbell at Oxford University. He then returned to Melbourne University as a Research Fellow in the Department of Chemistry, eventually moving to Monash as a Lecturer in the School of Biochemistry and Molecular Biology. Two years later he was offered a position as Principal Research Scientist with the Australian biotech company Biota where he worked for 13 years. Dr Morton returned to academia, working in Prof Michael Parker’s group at St Vincent’s Institute, when Biota closed its Australian research facility in 2014. Dr Morton’s research interests are in the structure-function relationship of proteins and the application of computational techniques to develop small-molecule modulators of protein function.
