

Acknowledging the Melbourne Histology Platform in research outputs



Requirement to acknowledge

As a condition of using the Melbourne Histology Platform (“the Platform”), all users are required to acknowledge the Platform in any research outputs – including but not limited to scientific journal articles, conference presentations (either oral or poster), and Honours/Masters/Doctoral theses – describing work which utilised the facilities and/or services of the Platform, and to notify the Platform Manager of such outputs.

Example acknowledgement formats for theses and articles

In Acknowledgements section

If Melbourne Histology Platform is the only University of Melbourne research platform used

- This research was supported by the facilities and services of the Melbourne Histology Platform.
- This research used the facilities/services [delete as appropriate] of the Melbourne Histology Platform.
- The authors thank [insert staff names] from the Melbourne Histology Platform for [describe as appropriate].

If multiple University of Melbourne research platforms used

- This research utilised the facilities and/or services of the following research platforms at The University of Melbourne: Melbourne Histology Platform, [insert other research platforms as appropriate].
- The authors thank the following platforms for the use of their facilities and services: Melbourne Histology Platform, [insert other research platforms as appropriate].

In Methods/Materials and Methods section

- **If user did their own histology:** [Insert technique(s)] were performed at the Melbourne Histology Platform (The University of Melbourne).
- **If staff performed the histology:** [Insert technique(s)] were performed by the Melbourne Histology Platform (The University of Melbourne).

Example acknowledgement formats for presentations/posters

Examples of acknowledgements from users
